#### Summary of Position

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The Enactus Team President is the lead communicator, manager, and supporter of the Enactus Team and its operations. The President develops strategic, team-level approaches to achieving the mission, vision, and operational objectives of the team, serving as an example for all other members and leaders in the team. The President will advise and mentor other team leaders, motivate members, and lead movement towards the team vision. The President works closely with the team's Sam Walton Fellows and University Administrators to support the development of the team and its operations.
